Measure	Estimated Cost	Activity / Justification
Improve access to home learning for those isolating following positive case in bubble.	CGP av Cost £2.50 per booklet 1 x reading + 1 x Maths + 1 x phonics per child = £2,606	To be sent home in addition to Class Dojo and Google lessons as some parents report no internet, or 1 device at home to share between siblings. Low take-up of full home learning opportunities during spring and summer terms. Parents not using video clips or high data content to support pupils' learning.
Improve rates of progress in early reading and phonics	£3,415	Implement new phonics programme (Monster Phonics) in response to school's historic underperformance in this area. Supplement KS2 readers to ensure high-quality, motivational texts are in place to challenge and inspire. Ensure all year groups have reading materials matched to phonic phase/ reading development stage. Begin to introduce class reading sets to supplement curriculum/ whole class readers across the school
Improve pupil's knowledge of basic skills in maths, especially number and calculation	£500	Introduce clear progression in mental maths and calculations through new programme and updated policies. Provide cover for intervention training run by North West Maths Hub Mastery Readiness Programme.
Implement Early Years language intervention	£500 Staff release time	Enrol on Nuffield Early Language Intervention to improve early language and literacy to children identified as in need of targeted support. https://educationendowmentfoundation.org.uk/covid-19-resources/neli/

Part-time teaching assistant to support learning in the Early Years	£6,784	Pupils typically significantly below on entry. Identified need through baseline for support for very low learners and increasing numbers of EAL pupils.
Increase attainment in writing across KS2, especially for PP children	16 x £150 = £2,400	One term daily release time for English subject leader to co-plan, deliver and resource writing workshop lessons with teachers across KS2
